*Conflict of Interest Statement **

Alkoholizmus a drogové závislosti (Protialkoholický obzor) requires all authors to declare any actual or potential conflicts of interest that may be inherent in their submissions. Actual or potential conflict of interest may arise upon author's: a) financial (e.g. honoraria, employment, consultancies, membership in advisory boards or speakers' bureaus, research or educational grants, conferences reimbursement, gifts, stock ownership) or b) non-financial (e.g. personal or professional relationships, beliefs) affiliations or involvements in the subject discussed in manuscript.

Public trust in the peer review process and the credibility of published articles depend in part on how well conflict of interest is handled during writing, peer review, and editorial decision making. Participants in publication should disclose their conflicting interests, and the information should be made available so that others can judge their effects for themselves.
