



Alkoholizmus a drogové závislosti (Protialkoholický obzor)

Statement of Informed Consent *

Alkoholizmus a drogové závislosti (Protialkoholický obzor) requires all authors to declare that all human subjects involved in research provided appropriate informed consent.

Patients have a right to privacy that should not be infringed without informed consent. Identifying information (including displaying of patients' faces, names, initials, or hospital numbers) must not be published unless written consent is given by the patient (or parent or guardian) and the information is essential for scientific purposes. Informed consent for this purpose requires that a patient who is identifiable be shown the manuscript to be published. In case of doubt regarding the character of the information, an informed consent is required, too.

The patient must be thoroughly informed about the purposes of the research, of the expected time of participation, as well of the procedures to be performed. Reasonable foreseeable risks, discomforts (adverse effects) and expected benefits (desirable effects) must be announced. The participation is voluntary, refusal will not be penalized in any way, and participation may be withdrawn without any type of penalty.

Upon the familiarization with the research details, the patient must sign and date the standard consent form: "I undersign that I have read and understood the information provided above. I voluntarily agree to participate in this study."
